Mark Thomas Williams, age 63, of Texarkana, Texas, died Thursday, March 12, 2015, at his residence. He was the retired owner of Blooms Landscape Gardens Inc., in Trophy Club, Texas, and a member of Williams Memorial United Methodist Church.
